MINUTES PARK, RECREATION & FORESTRY COMMISSION WEDNESDAY, FEBRUARY 21, 2018

- 1. The meeting was called to order by acting chairperson Paul Schmidt at 7:00 p.m.
- 2. Roll Call: Present: Heather Reekie, Paul Schmidt, Brad Stiner. Excused: Mark Giesfeldt, Derek Johnson. Also present: Dave Walker, Parks Director; Casey Dudley, Recreation Director; Jeff Mikorski, City Administrator; Adam Sayre and Kathrine Holt, Planning Department; Li Zhuang, UW-Madison Landscape Architecture Student; Andrew Bremer, Carter Arendt, and Dan Schmidt, MSA Professional Services.
- 3. Moved by Reekie, seconded by Schmidt, to approve the minutes of the January 17, 2018 meeting of the Park, Recreation, and Forestry Commission. Motion carried 3-0.
- 4. Li Zhuang, UW-Madison Landscape Architecture Student, was at the meeting to present a draft master plan for the quarry site at the corner of Nine Mound Rd and CTH PD. Li had selected developing a master park plan for the site as her senior project. She gave a very thorough presentation and discussed several different possibilities for the eventual development of the site. She will continue to refine the plan and present a final draft at a future meeting.
- 5. The Commission reviewed an updated master plan for Fireman's Park. Changes from the original 2016 plan included a smaller shelter, keeping the existing boat launch location, and retaining some open field area for youth soccer. The main elements of the plan remained the same and included a new shelter, splash pad, playground, paved paths, and expanded parking.
 - The cost estimate for construction of the new plan was also reduced from approximately \$4 million to \$3 million dollars. The Commission liked the new plan and recommended moving forward with implementing the project.
- 6. Moved by Schmidt, seconded by Reekie, to approve the Firemans Park Master Plan as presented and establish a project budget not to exceed \$3.1 million dollars. Motion carried 3-0.
- 7. Moved by Stiner, seconded by Reekie, to adjourn. Motion carried 3-0. Time 8:40 p.m.
