

REFUSE AND RECYCLING INFORMATION

The City of Verona contracts with Waste Management for curbside collection of household waste and recycling for residential properties only. Multi-family apartment buildings of five or more units, commercial properties and residences on private streets are NOT included in city service.

Waste and recycling containers must be placed curbside by 7:00 am (but not more than 24 hours in advance), and must be removed no later than 24 hours after collection. Waste Management will collect trash and recycling **between 7am and 6pm** on your designated service day. Carts need to be at least two feet away from each other and any fixed object. All carts should be at the curb with the handles facing the house.

If your refuse or recycling collection is missed, please call Public Works at (608) 845-6695 the following day. If your container is damaged, please call Waste Management at 1-866-909-4458 for a replacement.

Additional Cart Rental

In the event that one 96-gallon cart is not sufficient for your weekly refuse or bi-weekly recycling needs, you can rent a second cart. The current rate for one extra bin is \$5/month (minimum 1-year term) paid for in advance at the time of arrangement. CURBSIDE REFUSE SERVICE – Waste Management

Refuse is collected on a weekly basis. Please reference the collection zone map to determine if your pick up is Monday or Tuesday. The 96-gallon green bin with the green lid is for refuse/garbage. Recyclables in the refuse bin will not be collected. The weight limit for the cart is 200 pounds.

Extra Refuse: If you have more than will fit into your refuse cart, you may put out up to five extra bags or bins for collection next to your regular cart. Extra refuse may be no more than 50lbs in each bin or bag, up to 250 lbs of extra waste. Bulk waste is also collected curbside, see chart below.

Smaller 64-gallon carts will be available upon request to replace the 96-gallon cart by calling the Public Works Department at (608) 845-6695.

If residents miss their collection, or have excessive material, it can also be taken to the Dane County Landfill, 7102 US Hwy 12, Madison, WI 53718 (Beltline 12/18 East toward Cambridge across from the Yahara Hills Golf Course). <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Small appliances not banned from landfills (i.e. toasters) • Non-metal furniture (couches, desks, etc.) <i>*Sofa-sleepers must have metal bed frame removed and brought down to the Drop-off Site separately.</i> • Box springs and mattresses (must not be waterlogged) • Carpet and pads (no larger than 3 feet, rolled up and bound, not weighing more than 50 lbs. per roll) • Toilets and sinks • Remodeling materials: maximum of five 30 gal garbage cans not exceeding 50 lbs. each. Wood and drywall must be cut in three foot lengths and piled neatly. <p><i>NOTE: Any remodeling materials over this amount, you must contact Waste Management's Customer Service at 1-866-909-4458 to arrange for a dumpster.</i></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Large appliances (refrigerators, stoves, etc.) • Metals (including items 50% or more metal) • Lawn mowers and grills (empty of gas and oil) • Bicycles • TVs, computers, other e-waste (fee applies) • Large auto parts (engine blocks, fenders, tires, etc.) • Stone, concrete, rubble, earth or sod • Tires, off-rim (fee applies), car batteries and waste oil

CURBSIDE RECYCLING SERVICE – Waste Management

Recycling is collected every other week. Please use the collection zone map to determine if you live in a green or gold collection area, then reference the recycling calendar to determine green and gold weeks. Use the green cart with the yellow lid for recyclables only. Refuse placed in the recycling bin will not be collected. The weight limit for the cart is 200 lbs. The lid must be closed or the bin will not be collected.

Recyclable items

- Plastic bottles and containers
- Paper
- Flattened cardboard and paperboard
- Food and beverage cans
- Food and beverage cartons
- Glass bottles and containers

Extra Recyclables

Residents with extra cardboard can bring it to the Drop-off Site and put it in the cardboard dumpster. It must be collapsed and proof of residency is required. **Not for business use!**

Residents who regularly have more recyclables than fit in one bin please see “Additional Cart Rental” information on the previous page.

Plastic bags, plastic film, foam containers and Styrofoam, batteries and food waste are NOT currently collected for recycling in the City of Verona and can be placed in the refuse container. PUBLIC WORKS DROP-OFF SITE

The Public Works drop-off facility is for City of Verona residents ONLY. **Not for business use!**

Proof of residency is required (NOT available to residents of the Town of Verona, Town of Middleton, Town of Montrose, City of Fitchburg, City of Madison, etc.)

Refuse or recyclables that would otherwise be accepted curbside (such as mattresses) are NOT collected at this location. Fee items can be paid for with cash or check only.

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Metals (50% or more metal content) • Appliances (AC units, stoves, washers, dryers, water heaters, treadmills, refrigerators, etc.) • Lawn mowers and other power yard tools (must be free of fuel and oil) • Waste motor oil and motor oil filters from households • Landscape brick and block and untreated landscape timbers • Yard waste and brush (must be un-bagged) • Car batteries • Residential cardboard 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • TVs (27" and less): \$10 • TVs (greater than 27"): \$15 • Computers, monitors, laptops, notebooks, fax machine, DVD/VCR/DVR, game console: \$5 • Computer accessories (keyboards, speakers, etc), desktop printer, cell phones, electronic music players: \$2 • Tires (maximum four per household, must be off-rim): \$5/tire for car tires, \$20/tire for tractor-sized, must be from non-business use)

CURBSIDE BRUSH COLLECTION – Verona Public Works

Brush collection is a year-round service. It will be picked up curbside on the 2nd and 4th full weeks of the month, starting on the Monday of the week. For safety reasons, noncompliance of the guidelines described below will jeopardize collection of your brush.

- Collection is for tree trimmings, stumps and shrubs. Yard waste will **NOT** be collected with brush.
- Brush cut/trimmed by persons/firms hired by the property owner will **NOT** be collected.
- Brush must be neatly stacked and parallel to the street.
- In the event of a major storm, brush should be placed curbside and will be picked up as soon as possible.

CHRISTMAS TREE PICKUP

Pickup will be during the month of January. Place tree curbside, must be *unbagged* and bare of ornaments and decoration. Artificial trees and trees with stands will **NOT** be collected.

CURBSIDE FALL LEAF COLLECTION – Verona Public Works

This collection will begin in October and run through mid-November or until snowfall makes it impossible. Leaves, lawn clippings and garden debris should be placed into the curb and will be collected as quantity and time allows. Absolutely no bags! Do not pile leaves and garden debris with brush, please keep the piles separate.

Leaf and yard waste IS NOT collected any other time of the year!

What's the difference between brush & yard waste?

Brush	Yard Waste
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Limbs greater than half an inch in diameter (roughly as thick as your thumb) and greater than 12 inches long • Stumps (all soil must be removed) 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Grass clippings • Leaves, Weeds, Vines • Twigs less than half an inch in diameter (roughly as thick as your thumb) and less than 12 inches long • Vegetable / plant matter • Hay / straw
Materials Not Accepted	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Building debris (lumber, plywood, lattice, landscaping mulch, cabinets, etc.) 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Rocks • Dirt • Woody plants
Placement & Preparation	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Tree trunks and limbs must have branches trimmed off • Limbs must be no greater than 8 feet long • Lay branches parallel to the street in piles no longer than 8' (please limit the number of piles) • Pile brush neatly, do not put brush inside of cardboard boxes or plastic bags • Brush needs to be placed in the curb line of the road, away from any obstructions such as light poles or fire hydrants. • Have brush at the curb by 7:00 am Monday morning on the 2nd and 4th Mondays of the month 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Yard waste will <i>only</i> be collected in October and November. • Leaves need to be in a separate pile from any other yard waste • Have yard waste at the curb 7:00 am Monday morning on the 2nd and 4th Monday of October and November. • Yard waste can be taken to the City Drop-Off Site at any time during hours of operation stated above • No yard waste set out is the greenest option – resident mulches into the lawn or composts on site, reduces city labor and transportation costs
