NEW RESOURCE! “What Goes Where?”

Intent:

1. to drastically shorten the time residents need to search for information
2. to reduce “wish recycling” where recycling carts are contaminated with items residents *want* to recycle but are *not* included in the curbside recycling stream
3. to reduce refuse contamination, where refuse carts are contaminated with items that should otherwise have been recycled or taken to Dane County Clean Sweep, the Public Works Drop-off Site, or other depository



We have tried to be comprehensive, but if you know of a resource or item that is not listed in the “What Goes Where?” tool, please let us know!

Spring Stormwater Basin Burns

The City of Verona is scheduling spring burns of the vegetation in the stormwater basins listed below. The burns will be conducted by RES Great Lakes LLC, a company that has merged with Applied Ecological Services (the company the City has previously contracted with for this service). Basin burns are a widely accepted vegetation management technique that help promote native vegetation and suppress invasive plant species. Burns are usually scheduled in the spring due to a longer available burn season for favorable weather.

Typically, areas will be burned in two consecutive years to stimulate the native species. It will likely be three to five years before another burn is conducted after the second consecutive burn. 2022 Street Projects



1. Asphaltic street rehabilitation includes the replacement of deficient curb/gutter, sidewalk, and asphalt surface. Targeted streets are determined by an age/condition formula. The following streets are scheduled for **asphaltic rehabilitation** in 2022:

- Harmony Drive
- Todd Street (From W Verona Ave to Mark Dr)
- Military Ridge Drive (From Old PB to Glacier Ridge Trl)
- Walking path on Cross Country Rd from Hemlock Dr to N Main St

2. Crack filling seals major cracks in the asphalt surface. Chip sealing uses an asphalt emulsion with an aggregate topcoat. These treatments seal and enhance the life of the pavement surface. The following streets are scheduled for **granite chip seal** in 2022:
