3. Approval of Minutes from the August 15, 2022 Municipal Board of Canvassers Meeting
Motion by Sayre, seconded by Truman to approve the minutes from the August 15, 2022 Municipal Board of Canvassers meeting. Motion carried 3-0.
4. Processing and Counting of Provisional Ballots Received on Election Day
From wards 1-6, 13 (Verona Public Library Polling Place) 7 provisional ballots were outstanding after Election Day. The following voters provided acceptable ID before the deadline of 4:00 p.m. on Friday: Dylan Stone, Haley Jo Crossland, Nathan Nguyen, and Lane Weber. Their ballots were opened, and the votes were tallied.

Upon inspecting the ballots, the votes were added to the tally sheet and results tape for wards 1-6, 13. See tally sheet for breakdown of votes.
