1. The meeting was called to order by Holly Licht at 8:00 a.m.
2. Roll call: Kelly Fletcher, Kayla Truman, and Adam Sayre were present. Also present City Clerk Holly Licht.
3. Approval of Minutes from the April 11, 2022 Board of Canvassers Meeting:  
Motion by Sayre, seconded by Truman to approve the minutes of the April 11, 2022 meeting. Motion carried 3-0.
4. Processing and Counting of Provisional Ballots voted on Election Day:

From Wards 7-12 (City Hall Polling Place), 3 provisional ballots were voted on August 9, 2022 by Tiffany Butzbaugh, 607 Green Meadow Dr.; Allysha Nadine Valdez, 104 Lincoln St. #307; and Andrew Kuanhag Cheng, 104 Lincoln St. #301. Cheng provided his passport to inspectors on Election Day and his ballot was cast. Butzbaugh did not provide ID before the deadline. Her ballot Certificate Envelope was not opened, and no votes were tallied. A Wisconsin ID receipt was provided to the City Clerk on Thursday, August 11, 2022 by Valdez. The Provisional Ballot Reporting Form (EL-123r) was completed. The provisional ballot was assigned number S3 (1993). The Provisional Ballot Certificate Envelope was opened, and the votes were tallied as follows (one vote for each):
